VISUAL ARTS TERM 2: PRACTICAL 2

What is natural art?

Environmental **art** is a range of artistic practices encompassing both historical approaches to nature in **art** and more recent ecological and politically motivated types of works. ... It primarily celebrates an **artist's** connection with nature using **natural materials**.

Many forms of nature in art

Nature in **art** can take many visual **forms**, from photorealism to abstraction. **Art** can mimic **nature**, by seeking to visually replicate objects as they actually appear in real life. But abstract paintings can also take their visual cue from actual **forms** in **nature**, such as the paintings below.
